

2019 National Italian American Bar Association (NIABA) & Sons of Italy Foundation Scholarship



Eligibility: U.S. citizens of Italian descent <u>enrolled in a law school program</u> at an accredited academic institution for the **Fall 2019** term. Applicant must be a rising first, second or third year law student.

Deadline: February 28, 2019. All requirements must be met or the application will not be considered. All scholarship materials must be submitted online, and completed applications must be submitted by February 28, 2019. No exceptions will be made. The SIF takes no responsibility for incomplete or late applications.

Application & Requirements:

- Application Form
- **Official Transcripts**: Submit one official transcript from each academic institution (undergraduate, graduate and law school) attended through Dec. 2018.
- **Test Scores**: Submit copies of official results from all standardized tests (ACT, SAT, GMAT, GRE, LSAT, MCAT, etc.) taken during the past 5 years.
- **Resume**: Submit a current resume outlining extracurricular activities, work experience, volunteer service and honors.
- Letters of Recommendation: Submit 2 letters of recommendation from teachers, professors or educational administrators.
- **Essay**: Submit an original essay of 500-750 words about a personal experience which demonstrated or generated pride in your Italian heritage.
- Processing Fee (\$35)

How to Apply: All materials and applications will be accepted online ONLY at https://sonsofitalyfoundation.submittable.com

Process: Applications are screened by education professionals. Final selection is made by OSDIA's National Scholarship, Education and Culture Committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 1, 2018. Monetary awards are presented directly to the students' academic institutions in accordance with eligibility requirements

The winner of this scholarship will be required to become a member of NIABA. The first year is free.
